UNIFORM POLICY [Ver 3.2]

Our Hoxton Park High School uniform promotes a sense of belonging for students and creates a positive identity for the school community. School uniforms also contribute to the personal safety of students by allowing easier recognition of students inside the school and in the community. The uniform has been carefully designed and considered by the school community so it does not interfere with the learning and wellbeing of all students.

Schools expect students to wear the uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school, on out of school excursions and when engaged in school activities out of school hours.

Additional Information

- Formal and Sports Uniforms should be CLEARLY LABELLED with the student's name to avoid loss.
- Uniform is to be worn correctly at all times, and should not be adjusted. It must reflect the school standards of high expectation e.g. no rolling up of shirt sleeves, shorts or pant/trouser legs.
- If a student attends school with the incorrect uniform, e.g. wrong jumper, it is an expectation that, if available, an alternate washed uniform will be exchanged for the day.
- Students are permitted to wear a plain white t-shirt / long sleeve top underneath their school shirt or sports shirt.
- Head wear, i.e. scarf, must align to the school colours white, bottle green or black
- If a student is unable to wear their full *Formal Uniform*, they are to wear their full *Sports Uniform*. Likewise, if a student is unable to wear their full *Sports Uniform* (on specified days), they are to wear their full *Formal Uniform*. In both instances, the student must have a parent note supporting this and report to the Science Staffroom to receive a Blue Note

• Jewellery, Make-Up & Hair

- Jewellery is to be plain, minimal and should not cause any safety concerns
- Minimal make-up can to be worn pastel shades only and no dark/bold colours
- Nails are not to be long or pointed and should not cause safety concerns
- Hair is to be neat and tidy at all times, in practical classes all hair must be tied back.

OUT OF UNIFORM PROCEDURES

Before 8:48am

- Student who is out of uniform, presents to the Science Staffroom, where:
 - an alternate washed uniform, if available, will be exchanged for the day, e.g. a jumper. It is an
 expectation that the student will exchange the incorrect uniform for the correct uniform for the
 day, or
 - they will be issued with a Blue Note (BN) which they will need to present, upon request during the day.
 - A detention will be issued for students without a parent note with a valid excuse.

After 8:48am

- Assembly Days Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday
- The Uniform Check is conducted on the Assembly.
- Students out of uniform and without a BN, are recorded and are informed that they have a Break 1 (Mon to Thurs) or Break 2 (Fri) detention.
- A BN is issued on the Assembly, time permitting or during the Break detention.

No Assembly - Tuesdays and Rainy Days

- The Uniform Check is conducted in Roll Call.
- Students out of uniform and without a BN, are recorded and are informed that they have a Break 1 (Mon to Thurs) or Break 2 (Fri) detention.

<u>NOTE</u>: Students out of uniform and without a BN throughout the day are referred to the Deputy Principal.

Afterschool Detentions

- Failure to attend the uniform detention will result in an Afterschool Detention being issued
- Afterschool Detentions are held with the Principal on
 - Tuesdays between 2:30pm 3.00pm
 - Thursday between 3:10pm 3:40pm
