How to get started

Use these steps to get started with free eBooks, audiobooks, and more from your library:

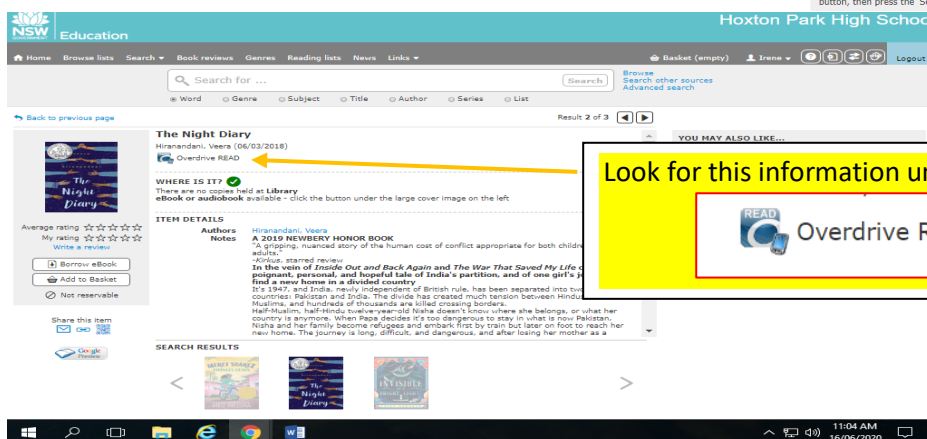
1. Find your library or school

Find and open your library or school's digital collection using one of the following:

- The original [OverDrive app](#) (download from your APP store)
 - Or -
- Open your OLIVER catalogue from the student portal and download using the QR code onto your device.

2. Borrow

- Borrow an e-Book title to read on your device.



- Borrow an audiobook title to listen to on your device.
